There is some confusion as to who Edward's parents are. At his first marriage in 1881, his parents' names are stated as Richard and Sarah, but at his second marriage in 1921, he gives the names James and Mary. These names are confirmed by brother? Thomas' marriage in 1887...

Searching the English census records turns up two possibilities for Edward. There is an Edward CHANNELL in the 1851 St. Pancras, MDX census, to parents Richard and Mary Ann, but his age is 1, making his birth date about 1850. Could he have mis-stated his age on all the Ontario documents, and been wrong about his mother's name? But that discounts Edward's 1921 assertion that he was born in Southampton... or was that just where he emigrated from?

More likely is an illegitimate Edward CHANNELL, born 20 JUN 1860, and baptized 09 SEP 1860 at St. Martin's, Epsom, SRY to unwed mother Eliza CHANNELL. They appear in the Union Workhouse in Epsom, her age shown as 19. She was born in Leatherhead, SRY. In 1851 she lived with her grandparents, farm labourer and former baker William CHANNEL (CHENNELL) (66, born in Surrey) and his wife Sarah (55, born Surrey). They lived in the Almshouses in Clepington in 1851.

1878: Immigrated to Canada (1901 Hallowell Township census)

1881: Not yet found in Canadian 1881 census...

1887: Resident at Green Point, Sophiasburgh, Prince Edward County.

1891: Lived with wife Martha and three children in Hallowell Township. Edward MILLER (45, Blacksmith) and Nelson

E. MILLER (21, Labourer) lived with the family. They are likely Martha's father and brother respectively.

1901: Edward's birth date is shown as 01? MAY 1861 in the Hallowell Township census.

1921: Residence in Bloomfield at time of second marriage. Note that at that marriage, Edward gives his parents' names as James CHANNELL and Mary CHANNELL, with a note on the certificate that he could not remember his mother's maiden name. He states that he was born in Southampton, England, and also mentions that his father was born "somewhere in England".

The Maple Inn

"Bloomfield's most famous dining establishment held sway in the village from 1944 to 1992. The original building housing the Maple Inn was a two storey farmhouse which belonged to one of the oldest farms in the village. It was built around 1810 by the Bowerman family, and remained in the family for many years.

"By 1926, it was sold to Bert and Leila Pearsoll and in 1944, George Channell, a cheesemaker with the Bloomfield Cheese Factory bought the property and, on Easter Sunday, April 9, 1944 he opened the 'Maple Inn'.

"George Channell was very fond of cooking and was an excellent chef. The Maple Inn was destined to become one of the most popular restaurants in the area and drew patrons from as far away as Toronto and Montreal. Throughout the 1950s and 1960's, its menu of locally-grown produce and freshly-cooked meals made it a stopping point not only for local patrons but also for visitors.

"During the early 1970's, Prince Andrew, now Duke of York, Queen Elizabeth's second son, who had friends in this area, dined at the Maple Inn.

"George and his wife Florence, introduced overnight accommodation, but this was never a large part of the business.

"The first major change to the building was to enclose the front (porch)"

The Channells sold the Inn in 1975, which subsequently burned March 7, 1992.
