"A numerous family, but one that has well maintained the traditions of its distinguished ancestry, is descended from John Ham, who was a gallant soldier of the King during the War of the Revolution. Many anecdote are told that illustrate his strenuous activity; upon one occasion it is said that he received a flesh wound and having a comrade extract the bullet, ordered him to "fire it back at the Yankee who shot it." At the close of the Revolution he settled at Ernestown, and by his wife, Elizabeth Dunsbaugh, had many descendants. They in turn has intermarried with many of the oldest and most substantial families of the Bay district. As a rule the Hams have been thrifty and well-to-do and have always occupied an honorable place in the community. Mrs. Vrooman, the mother of Dr. J.P. Vrooman, of Napanee, is the daughter of Richard Ham who married Sarah Blanchard, seventh son and child of the pioneer.

"Zina Ham, son of Rev. John Ham, was born in Fredericksburgh, where he resided for forty years. He is at present carrying on the insurance business at Napanee. He is of a vigorous personality, a shrewd and successful business man, but of frank, sunny disposition, of pleasant address and universally esteemed by all who know him. He is a Conservative in politics, and belongs to the Church of England. His only child, John S. Ham, also resides in Napanee with his wife (formerly Miss Helen Miller) and their two sons, Douglas Miller and Kenneth Sheridan."

"The old Township of Adolphustown and indeed this whole county, has lost one of its oldest and best known native residents in the death of Henry Allison, which occurred at his residence, the old family homestead, the 11 inst. He was born in the old family homestead, which has been occupied by the Allison family ever since the first UE Loyalists came to this county in 1784, and lived on that well-known farm the entire seventy-seven years of his life.

"After the American Revolution the family, which was a large one, got very widely scattered in the States and Canada. In the Maritime provinces, as well as pretty generally throughout Ontario, the family is now well represented. The deceased was kindly and neighborly gentleman, a man of more than ordinary industry, intelligence, information, and ability, always deeply interested in the early history of the Midland District and Adolphustown.

"He was a son of the late Joseph Allison, J.P., for many years a prominent citizen, taking an active interest in the moral, educational and religious progress of this county. He was a man of staunch and liberal views. His surviving brothers are David W., ex- M.P., and formerly a Warden of our County Council; Cyrus, of Parma, also a Warden of this County Council; Joseph, and ex-Reeve of Adolphustown; Edward, Port Perry. Surviving sisters are Mrs. Rev. Briden of Kingston; Mrs. Lewis Brown of Adolphustown; Mrs. Nelson Mallory, of Mallory's Point, Adolphustown.

"He married a daughter, years ago of the late Solomon Wright, of Fredericksburgh, and their two sons, Harry of Conway, and Fred, who resides on the old homestead, survive him. There are also a large number of respected and influent relatives well-known throughout this county. It may be here remarked that Mr. Allison took considerable pride over the fact that there stood on his farm probably the oldest barn in the county, having been built by a Mr. Secord, a carpenter, who soon after was interested in the building of the Major VanAlstine grist mill before 1800 at Glenora, which was said to have been the first flour mill in Prince Edward county.
