The second person buried in this place, while it was yet a woods, was Casper Hover. Short lived was his career as a pioneer. But a few months had passed, and he had barely taken possession of his land when, one day engaged in clearing off the land, he was struck by a falling limb and killed. A blow so sudden was felt not alone by his own family, but by all the settlers. Imagination cannot call up the heart-stirring scene of this burial in the woods by his comrades. As there was yet no roads nor path, not unlikely the body was conveyed by batteau from Hover's farm to the burying ground. The coffin must have been made of rough green boards, split out of logs, or perhaps made with a whip saw. There was no minister to discharge any rights belonging to the dead, or improve the events for the spiritual welfare of the living.

Casper Hover had for his wife Barbara Monk, a relative of Barbara Heck, well known for her connection with early Methodism in the new world. There remains now in possession of Joseph Allison, of Adolphustown, whose wife was a Hover, a pewter platter which belonged to Barbara Monk. It is a relic of no ordinary interest. Barbara Monk was a descendant of the Palatines, and this platter was carried by her ancestors when they were forced to leave the Palatinate. They took it with them to Ireland, thence to New York, and finally it was brought by Barbara to Adolphustown, with VanAlstine's company. The writer has had the satisfaction of examining this relic of former days. It is a round dish, of solid metal, 16 inches broad, and weighing over five pounds. It bears no signs of wearing out. This article of household usefulness is, or was in the past, regarded as a township one, and was famous for its associations with innumerable pot pies. For many a year when there was a bee, or a raising, or a wedding, the pewter platter was engaged to do service.

"On the 21st of April, there passed away to peaceful rest the last of Sir John A. McDonald's school mates of the old U.E.L. school house, which they attended away back before they struck their teens, in the presence of Mrs. Amey Gunsolus, (nee Amey Allison), sister of the late D.W. Allison, ex-M.P., Mrs Gunsolus had reached the ripe age of 89 years, 2 months and 11 days.

"She leaves three brothers and two sisters to mourn her loss, Cyrus Allison, Ex-warden of the county; Joseph Allison, both of Adolphustown; and Edward Allison, of Port Perry; Mrs. Briden, of Kingston, and Mrs. W.N. Mallory, of Adolphustown. The remains were placed in the mausoleum, on the 23rd, now belonging to the heirs of her late

brother, D.W. Allison, and erected by him in 1873 at a cost of six thousand dollars, - there to wait the sounding of the trumpet at the last day, when if a million years of more should lapse in the interval, the time spent in this sweet sleep would not seem any longer to the just than the twinkling of an eye.

"Her sermon was preached by Rev. M. Boyce, who did justice to one so worthy of it, at the U.E.L. Memorial Methodist church of this place. The U.E.L. school house, referred to above, has long since passed away by fire, and the butment stones are still to be seen where it stood, on the property now owned by Frederick Membery, of this place, and about a hundred yards east on the road side of the U.E.L. Memorial Anglican church, in the village of Adolphustown.

"Mrs. Gunsolas, on the last day of February last, gave Mr. Membery her recollections of the school house, the teachers, the attendants, who came here from Kingston, Ernesttown, and a wide range from her, with the names of many of the scholars, for the Historic Society of Lennox and Addington, at Napanee, and the same has been forwarded to the Secretary, Mr. Clarence Warner, and the receipt of it has been acknowledged by him. She signed her name with a steady hand, and her mind was as clear as ever. The funeral was the largest seen for years, the church being crowded beyond seating room."

"The oldest son, David Wright Allison left home at an early age and made considerable money in timber lots and iron mines in Michigan and Northern Ontario. He retired early, returned to Adolphustown, married and built a fine house. The house is situated in the UEL Adolphustown Park, near the Old UEL burying ground. He also built an impressive mausoleum in honour of his parents. The mausoleum and surrounding cemetery is on the homestead property and is intended for the use of all Joseph and Mary's descendants."

"D.W. ALLISON - For two weeks past a prominent citizen of the township of Adolphustown, and widely known and esteemed throughout Lennox, Mr. D.A. Allison, was gradually sinking, and on Tuesday afternoon the end came. deceased had attained the patriarchal age of eighty-five years, but there is little doubt that his death was prematurely hastened through an accident at Picton over a year ago, when he was knocked down by a runaway horse, and so badly shaken up and injured that from that time on his decline was marked. David W. Allison was a son of the late Joseph Allison, if U.E. stock, and one of a large family. The remaining brothers are Cyrus Allison, Parma; Joseph Allison, Adolphustown. John and Henry died some few years ago. The sisters are Mrs. Gunsolas, Adolphustown; Mrs. W. Briden, Kingston, and Mrs. Mallory, Adolphustown. Besides his widow, one daughter and three sons survive. They are Miss Mamie Allison, Adolphustown; Dr. David Allison in the United States; John B.

Allison, collector of customs, Napanee and Raymond Allison, at home. Deceased was a Methodist in religion. The funeral service was held in the U.E.L. Methodist church on Thursday afternoon, and was attended by a large concourse of people, many of whom came from a distance to pay a last tribute of respect to their departed friend. Rev. W.S. Boyce conducted the services, and the remains were place in the family mausoleum."

"The old Township of Adolphustown and indeed this whole county, has lost one of its oldest and best known native residents in the death of Henry Allison, which occurred at his residence, the old family homestead, the 11 inst. He was born in the old family homestead, which has been occupied by the Allison family ever since the first UE Loyalists came to this county in 1784, and lived on that well-known farm the entire seventy-seven years of his life.

"After the American Revolution the family, which was a large one, got very widely scattered in the States and Canada. In the Maritime provinces, as well as pretty generally throughout Ontario, the family is now well represented. The deceased was kindly and neighborly gentleman, a man of more than ordinary industry, intelligence, information, and ability, always deeply interested in the early history of the Midland District and Adolphustown.

"He was a son of the late Joseph Allison, J.P., for many years a prominent citizen, taking an active interest in the moral, educational and religious progress of this county. He was a man of staunch and liberal views. His surviving brothers are David W., ex- M.P., and formerly a Warden of our County Council; Cyrus, of Parma, also a Warden of this County Council; Joseph, and ex-Reeve of Adolphustown; Edward, Port Perry. Surviving sisters are Mrs. Rev. Briden of Kingston; Mrs. Lewis Brown of Adolphustown; Mrs. Nelson Mallory, of Mallory's Point, Adolphustown.

"He married a daughter, years ago of the late Solomon Wright, of Fredericksburgh, and their two sons, Harry of Conway, and Fred, who resides on the old homestead, survive him. There are also a large number of respected and influent relatives well-known throughout this county. It may be here remarked that Mr. Allison took considerable pride over the fact that there stood on his farm probably the oldest barn in the county, having been built by a Mr. Secord, a carpenter, who soon after was interested in the building of the Major VanAlstine grist mill before 1800 at Glenora, which was said to have been the first flour mill in Prince Edward county.

"Few families have occupied so long a prominent position in municipal and political affairs, in church and educational matters than that of which the deceased was a respected member."

Joseph B. ALLISON - For the past four weeks, Mr. J.B. Allison, a prominent citizen of Adolphustown and a man widely known and highly esteemed throughout Lennox County, was gradually sinking and on Tuesday evening of last week, the end came. Deceased had reached the patriarchal age of ninety-six years and ten months.

"Joseph B. Allison was a son of the late Joseph B. Allison of U.E. loyalist stock, and is the last one of the large family of ten children. His wife, Martha M. Membery predeceased him fifty-five years ago. Two daughters and one son, also five grandchildren and three great-grandchildren survive. His children are Mrs. T.N. David, of Dorland, with whom he has spent the last two years; Miss Edna Allison, R.N., of Honolulu, and Arthur Allison, who lives on the homestead.

"The funeral service was held in the U.E.L. United Church, Thursday afternoon last, and was attended by a large number of friends, many of whom came from a distance to pay a last tribute of respect to their departed friend. Ref. G. Gardner conducted the services and the remains were place in the family mausoleum.

"Some time after leaving school, the late Mr. Allison entered the law office of W.H. Allison, Q.C., Picton. Not liking the work, he decided to return to the farm. He was a consistent reformer and his public career was one of efficient service. He was a salesman for the U.E.L. Cheese Factory for twenty-nine years. In 1866 he married Martha M. Membery, a member of one of the oldest families in the township and for forty years lived on the farm where his son now resides. Deceased was a staunch member of the United Church. He was the last person living who attended the old Hay Bay church as a boy."

"William Henry Richey ALLISON, a prominent barrister in the county of Prince Edward and a surrogate judge of the Maritime Court of Ontario, was born near Brockville, on April 17, 1836. His father, Rev. Cyrus R. Allison, a noted Wesleyan Minister, was also a native of this Province, preached for many years in the vicinity of the Bay of Quinte,

and died at Picton, in 1869. The mother of our subject was Eve Hoover, also a native of Ontario, and the daughter of a United Empire Loyalist. She is still living.

"Mr. Allison was educated at Victoria College, Cobourg; studied law with Philip Low, Q.C., of Picton; was called to the Bar at Michaelmas term, 1864, and from that date has been in constant practice in this town. He does business in all the courts, and his standing is second to that of no lawyer in the county. He is well read; prepares his case with great care; is painstaking in all his legal work, and has great influence with a jury, being clear, argumentative, forcible and persuasive. His success at the Bar has been quite mote-worthy.

"Mr. Allison was in the town council many years; was one of the first directors of the Prince Edward railway, which was opened from Picton to Trenton in 1879; is one of the trustees of the public schools, and was appointed a surrogate judge of the Maritime Court of Ontario in 1879.

"His political proclivities are to the Reform side, and at times, during an animated canvass he has done "yeoman service" for his party on the "stump."

"He is an Odd Fellow, being a member of the Grand Lodge of Ontario; and is also a member of the Methodist church of Canada.

"In September, 1861, Mr. Allison was united in marriage—with Miss Anna M., daughter of John P. Roblin, deceased, late registrar of Prince Edward county, and for many years a member of Parliament, and they have one son, Malcolm Roblin, who is pursuing his studies in the local schools.

"The father-in-law of our subject mentioned above, was one of those bold spirits who fought the battle for "Responsible Government" in Parliament, and broke up the so-called "Family Compact." His memory is cherished very sacredly in Picton and the county of Prince Edward."

"Henry William Branscombe, Picton, Ontario, was born at Hallowell, County of Prince Edward in 1837. His father, Arthur Branscombe, was the grandson of a British officer, who served in the war of the American revolution, and after the treaty of 1783, removed to Grand Lake, Queen's County, New Brunswick, at which place a large number of the same name still reside. Early in the present century, the grandfather and father of Mr. Branscombe removed to Hallowell, Upper Canada, and settled near what is now the village of Bloomfield.

"Arthur Branscombe married Catherine Burlingham, daughter of a U.E. loyalist, who came from Dutchess County, N.Y., at the close of the war. The Burlingham's were amongst the most successful of the old settlers of Prince Edward county, and constitute, today, one of the most extensive and respectable families in that county.

"Henry W. Branscombe was educated in his native township, and at an early age commenced the study and practice of dentistry, in which profession he has risen to the foremost rank. in 1862 he left his native town for New York city, where he practised his profession with marked success for five years. He then returned to Picton, and after a sojourn of a few years, removed to Chicago, where he remained until 1879, when he returned to Canada and permanently settled in Picton. His careful steady and industrious pursuit of knowledge, together with the deep interest he has always taken in dentistry, secured for him an honourable recognition by his professional brethren, in his election to the position of secretary to the Dental Association for Ontario. After his removal to Picton, he combined the business of chemist and druggist with that of dentistry, and has for several years successfully conducted both branches.

"In local enterprise Mr. Branscombe has been found to give a helping hand. For five consecutive years he has occupied a seat at the council board, where he has made his influence felt to a marked degree. He has for years been a director of the County Agricultural Society, and is also a treasurer of the Bay of Quinte Fire Insurance Company. He is an active member of the Methodist church, and enthusiastic worker for the cause of temperance.

"Henry W. married in 1866, Sara Elizabeth Allison, daughter of the late Rev. Cyrus Allison, whose name is familiar amongst the temperance workers who under the appellation of the Women's Christian Temperance Union have done so much of late years to arouse public opinion upon this important question".
