# **Hyatt Family of Cayuga County, New York**

## Generation One

1. **Elijah Hyatt** #100749, b. c 1814 in Upper Canada, occupation 1850 - 1853 Farmer in Ira, Cayuga County, New York, occupation 1855 - 1860 Farmer in Rock County, Wisconsin, d. 06 September 1905? in Rock County, Wisconsin, USA.<sup>2</sup>

How do these Hyatt's connect with other West Lake families?
The gravestone for son Nathan and family is in the Disciple Cemetery at West Lake.
I suspect that Elijah HYATT is related to the Sherbrooke HYATT group (see hya71789.pdf)

1851: Family lived in Ira, Cayuga County, New York (just north-west of Syracuse, and mid-way between Syracuse and Lake Ontario).

2. **Nathan Hyatt** #71511, b. February 1836 in Ontario\*, docupation 1871 Labourer in Hallowell Township, d. 02 June 1912 in 35 McGill Street, Toronto, York County, Ontario, buried in Disciples of Christ Cemetery, West Lake, Prince Edward County, Ontario.

1850: Ira, Cayuga County census shows birthplace as "Canada".

1871: Birthplace shown as "Ontario" in 1871 census; but on daughter Gertrude's 1944 death certificate, it appears as "U.S.A.".

1921 census gives Nathan's birthplace as "Ontario", his wife Cornelia's as "U.S.A.". The consensus of opinion suggests the "Ontario" birthplace.

1861: Lived in Fulton, Rock County, Wisconsin with family. Enumerated next to father Elijah HYATT, 46, born Upper Canada.

1871: Lived with family in Hallowell Township, Prince Edward County, Ontario.

1911: Lived with wife, daughter Gertrude in Toronto. Alex HUNTER and George CARUTHERS are shown as lodgers, as is Wilbert MAY, b JUL 1888. Wilbert was s/of daughter Gertrude and husband Samuel MAY.

1912: Death record incorrectly shows "Scotland" as birthplace.

He married **Cornelia A. Madill** #71512, b. c 1837 in New York, United States, 4,1 d. 22 March 1921 in 35 McGill Street, Toronto, York County, Ontario, buried in Bloomfield Cemetery\*, Prince Edward County, Ontario. 8

1871: Census gives "Ontario" birthplace, but marriage record states birthplace of "Rock County, Wisconsin".

1921: Lived at 35 McGill street, Toronto with family. widowed.

1921: Informant at mother's death. Lived at 35 McGill Street, Toronto.

She married **Samuel Fletcher May** #100737, 14 September 1887 in Ameliasburgh, Prince Edward County, Ontario, <sup>11</sup> b. c March 1851 in Murray Township, Northumberland County, Ontario, <sup>12</sup> (son of **John May** #100738 and **Frances** 

**Powers** #100739), occupation 1887 Farmer in Murray Township, d. 31 December 1818 in Murray Township, Northumberland County, Ontario. <sup>13</sup>

He married **Olive Mildred Richards** #100741, 20 December 1919 in Toronto, York County, Ontario, <sup>16</sup> b. 01 February 1896 in Trenton, Ontario, <sup>15,17</sup> (daughter of **Thomas Burton (Bert) Richards** #100742 and **Maggie Bennett** #100743), baptized 14 September 1899 in Murray Township, Northumberland County, Ontaro, <sup>17</sup> occupation Registered Nurse, d. 1984 in Wooler, Hastings County, Ontario, <sup>18</sup> buried in Wooler Friends Cemetery, Hastings County, Ontario.
