

By June 3rd, 2017, water levels have remained very high around the Park.

These images, taken June 3rd, 2017 show that levels have not gone down at all in the past two weeks, and with a good south-westerly wind from Lake Ontario, shoreline erosion can now be seen, especially in the turbid and turbulent waters off West Point.

We can only hope for warmer weather to mitigate these water levels.
